



Environmental Requirements for Suppliers

Suppliers and subcontracts are required to:

- Comply with all applicable provisions of law and regulations relating to the environment and pro-actively take measures contributing to the protection of broadly understood ecosystem;
- Implement measures aimed at reduction of consumption of raw materials and resources, minimizing at the same time pollution and waste generation;
- Encourage their own suppliers and subcontractors to raise awareness of responsibility for the environment, initiate their own environmental protection programmes and apply sustainable development policy;
- Ensure that means of transport are maintained in good technical condition and that they meet all emission standards;
- Promote development and implementation of technologies contributing to reduction in greenhouse gas emissions, as well as energy consumption;
- Ensure that all dangerous substances and mixtures used for and on the premises of Kuźnia Polska S.A. have original and clear markings (pictograms) on their packaging;
- Ensure that all dangerous substances and mixtures stored and used on the premises of Kuźnia Polska S.A. are protected so as not to cause any danger to the environment and people;
- Hold all the permits or licences relating to the environmental protection, required under applicable provisions of law, necessary for proper performance of the agreement;
- Hold safety data sheets relating to dangerous substances and mixtures used in their activities and provide training to all subordinate personnel on the knowledge of the same;
- Make sure that waste sorting and collection is done with utmost efficiency, allowing to achieve the highest possible recycling rate;
- Remove waste generated during performance of work for Kuźnia Polska S.A. and on the company premises, in accordance with applicable provisions of law, unless provisions of the agreement provide otherwise;

Suppliers and subcontractors are fully liable for any possible culpable environmental damage caused as a result of their activities.
